

PPHIS Reference Materials Search Tips

This search tool is unfortunately NOT as smart as Google.

1. It will search for the keyword in the file title and in the document contents, but prioritizes the title.
2. You do have to **spell correctly**.
3. But the search is **not case sensitive**. “Imms”, “IMMS” and “imms” will all work.
4. It will search for the **exact term** you enter. If you enter “Administer Imms”, it **won’t** find “Administered Imms”. “Immunoglobulin” **won’t** find “Immuno Globulin”.
5. If you aren’t sure what the keyword should be, or if you don’t know how to spell something, **try using the * wild card**. For example “admin* Imm*” will find “Administer Imms”, “Administered Imms”, “Administer Immunizations” and “Administered Immunizations”, etc. **Note: the % wildcard does NOT work in this search tool.**
6. If you know the exact keyword you are looking for, put quotation marks before and after the keyword to get more focused results.

Search in the right place

- The **search bar in centre of the page** searches PPHIS documents.
- The top search bar on the right searches everything on phsa.ca.
