1-7 & Tin



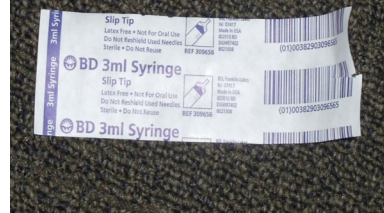
Blue Wrap:
Clean Plastic
1-7 & Tin



Plastic front of
syringe package:
Clean Plastic
1-7 & Tin



Rubber Glove Box:
Mixed Paper



Paper backing of
syringe package:
Mixed Paper

If backing of medical supply packaging can be ripped, it can go to mixed paper. If not, put in garbage



Sterile Water/saline
bottles:
Clean Plastic
1-7 & Tin



Needle caps:
Clean Plastic
1-7 & Tin



Syringe (without
sharp):
Clean Plastic
1-7 & Tin

Any piece of rigid/hard plastic is accepted in the rigid plastic stream. No minimum size restrictions or number required.



Plastic Containers:
Clean Plastic
1-7 & Tin



IV Bag (no tubing):
Garbage



Gloves (clean or
soiled):
Garbage



Mixed Metal
Packaging:
Garbage



Medical Tubing:
Garbage
