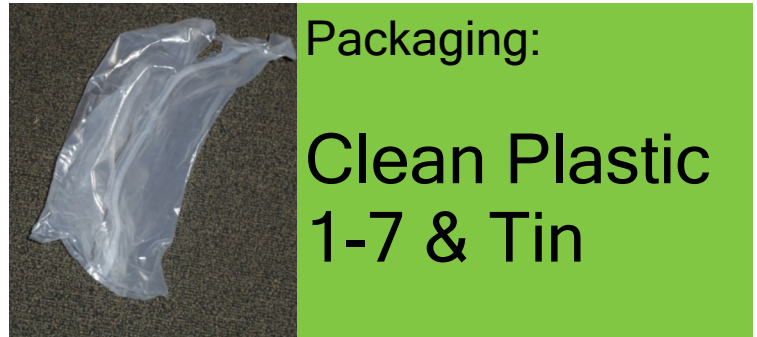

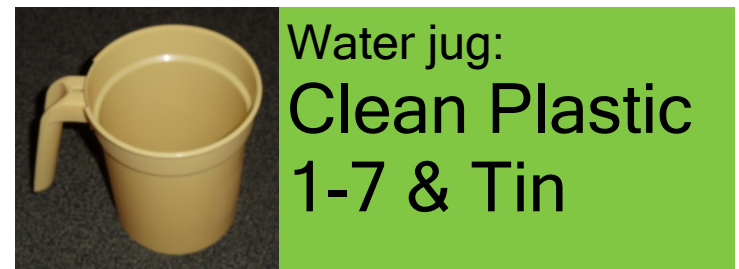

Clean Plastic 1-7 & Tin

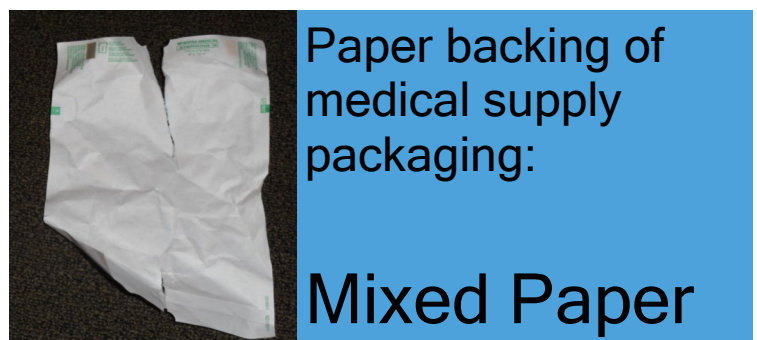


Syringe (no sharp):

Mixed Paper

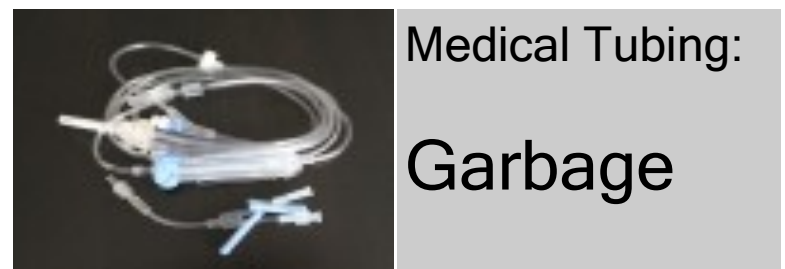


Paper backing of medical supply packaging:

If backing of medical supply packaging can be ripped, it can go to mixed paper. If not, put in garbage



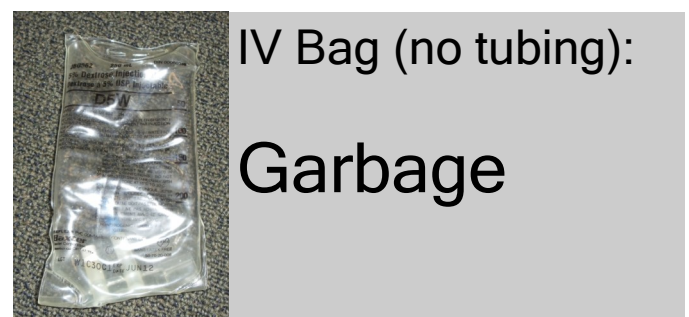
Mixed Metal Packaging:
