Packaging:
Clean Plastic 1-7 & Tin



IV Bag packaging:
Clean Plastic 1-7 & Tin



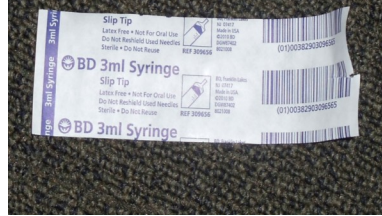
Diaper packaging:
Clean Plastic 1-7 & Tin



Plastic front of syringe package:
Clean Plastic 1-7 & Tin



Breast milk container (rinsed):
Clean Plastic 1-7 & Tin



Paper backing of syringe package:
Mixed Paper



Enfamil water and supplements (no lid):
Clean Plastic 1-7 & Tin



Rubber Glove Box:
Mixed Paper

If backing of medical supply packaging can be ripped, it can go to mixed paper. If not, put in garbage



Distilled Water jug:
Clean Plastic 1-7 & Tin



Syringe (without sharp):
Clean Plastic 1-7 & Tin



Sterile Water/saline bottles:
Clean Plastic 1-7 & Tin



Sterile water for Injection (no rubber or aluminum):
Clean Plastic 1-7 & Tin



IV Bag (no tubing):
Garbage



Sterile cups for breast milk storage (rinsed):
Clean Plastic 1-7 & Tin



Blood pressure cuff:
Garbage

Any piece of rigid/hard plastic is accepted in the rigid plastic stream. No minimum size restrictions or number required.



Medical Tubing:
Garbage



Plastic bottle with medication:
Pharmaceutical
