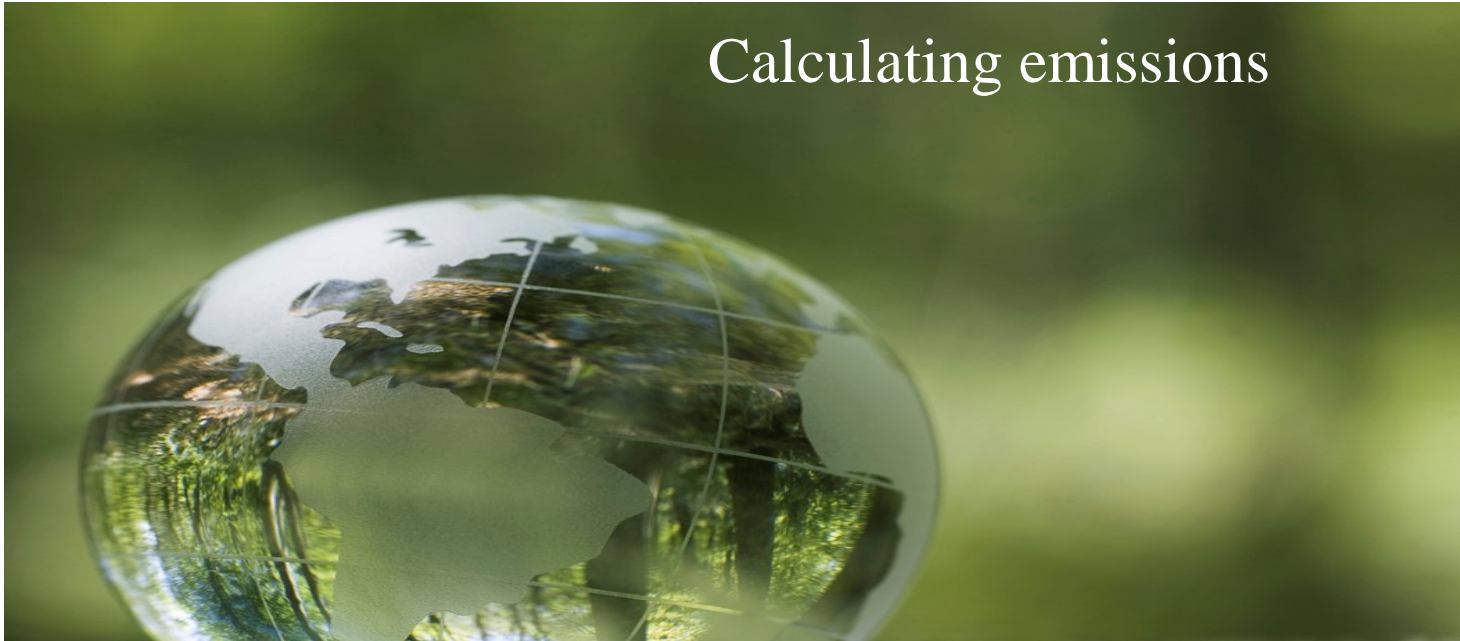


Leadership – A/G Model

UPS – UBC Route Statistics

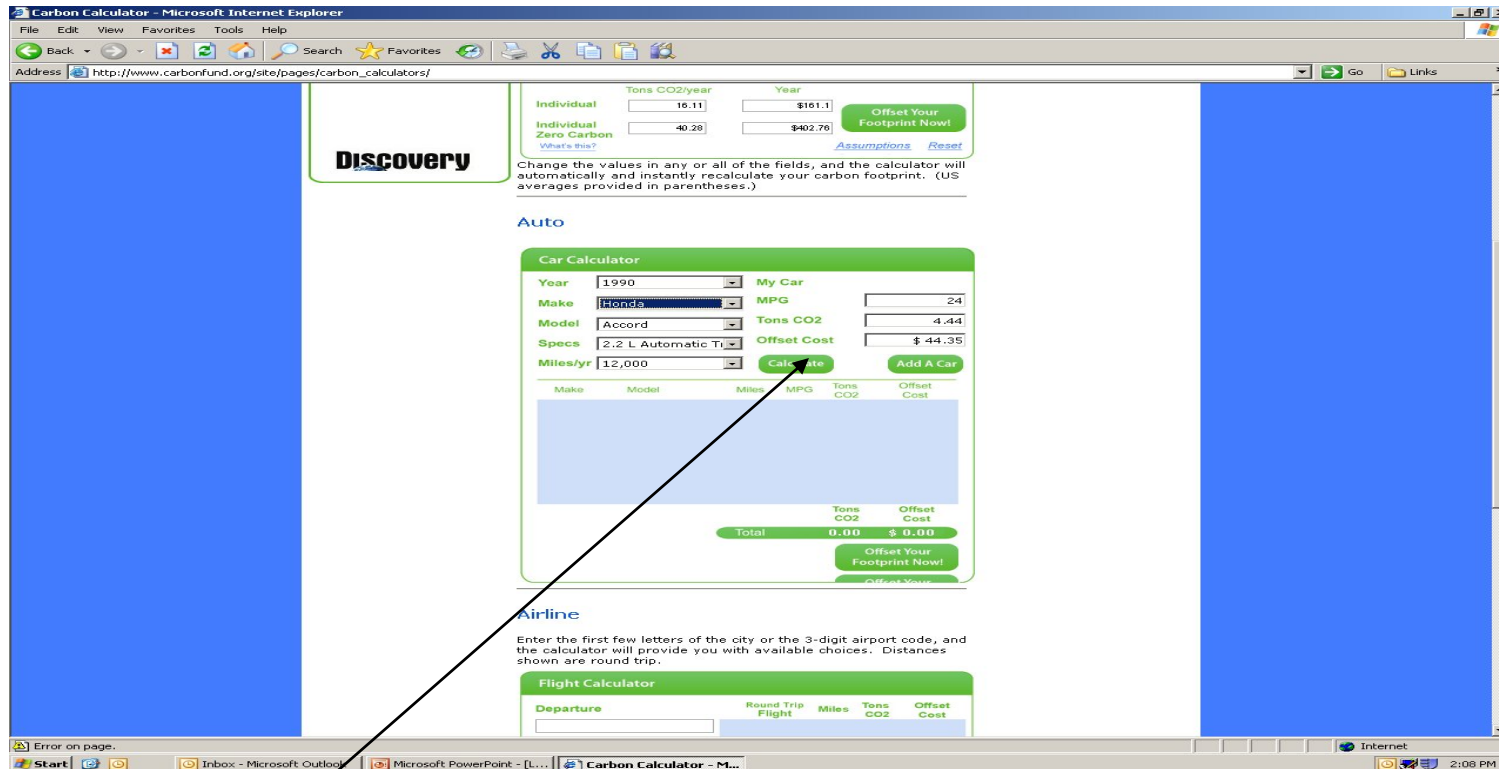
avg daily delivery volume	139 pcs

Include “company profile” in our RFP’s

- What are the social and environmental impacts associated with the products we are sourcing and the methods used to get them to us?
- Does your company have a sustainability or environmental policy or statement?
- Do you adhere to, or have membership with any internationally recognized standards or principles promoting sustainability?

Develop matrix that includes weighting for Sustainability

- Cost matrix that includes relative waste and disposal costs. - packaging
- Carbon calculations
- Weighting factors for sustainability
(could be = to price)

Work closely with purchasing !

Be integrated in the decision making process.
