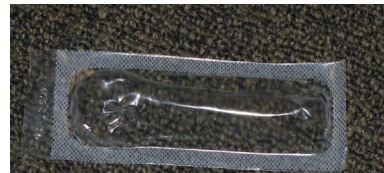
Packaging:  
**Soft Plastic**



IV Bag packaging:  
**Soft Plastic**



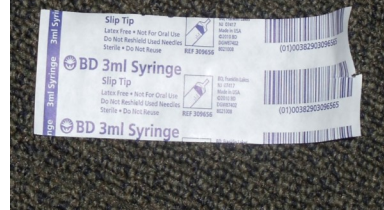
Blue Wrap:  
**Soft Plastic**



Plastic front of syringe package:  
**Soft Plastic**



Rubber Glove Box:  
**Mixed Paper**



Paper backing of syringe package:  
**Mixed Paper**

If backing of medical supply packaging can be ripped, it can go to mixed paper. If not, put in garbage



Sterile Water/saline bottles:  
**Rigid Plastic & Tin**



Needle caps:  
**Rigid Plastic & Tin**



Syringe (without sharp):  
**Rigid Plastic & Tin**

Any piece of rigid/hard plastic is accepted in the rigid plastic stream. No minimum size restrictions or number required.



Plastic Containers:  
**Rigid Plastic & Tin**



IV Bag (no tubing):  
**Garbage**



Gloves (clean or soiled):  
**Garbage**



Mixed Metal Packaging:  
**Garbage**



Medical Tubing:  
**Garbage**
