What is new in stroke research?

Exposure to Air Pollution Linked to Increased Risk of Stroke Within 5 Days

Previous research has established a connection between long-term exposure to air pollution and an increased risk of stroke. This study, revealed that short-term exposure (within five days) to air pollution also has significant correlations with both stroke onset and related fatalities.

Reproductive Lifespan Linked to Cerebrovascular Disease Risk

Women with more prolonged exposure to endogenous hormones show relatively smaller burden of cerebral small vessel disease independent of history of oral contraceptive use or hormone replacement therapy.
