**Live out your “green” values in the workplace as a PHSA Green+Leader (G+L)! Join 250 staff volunteers who are committed to creating and fostering a culture of sustainability at PHSA and other health organizations across the Lower Mainland.**

Reporting as a volunteer to the Green+Leaders program coordinator, you will act as a role model to encourage your colleagues to: 1) improve energy conservation and help meet BC's climate neutral goals; 2) promote active and clean transportation options for overall health and wellness; 3) reduce material use and promote re-use, such as paper and other supplies; and 4) compost and recycle appropriately.

With the support of the program coordinator you will also have plenty of opportunities to get creative and develop unique sustainability projects in your department.

With your supervisor's permission, you will:

- Attend two mornings of orientation and training in September 2015
- Carry out up to four (4) campaigns between October and May
- Meet and share stories with other G+Ls at monthly luncheons
- Have fun!

As a Green+Leader, you'll benefit from:

- Unique training, tools and events;
- A community of supportive and like-minded people;
- Fun and inspiring opportunities to have a powerful impact in your workplace and community.

Green+Leaders (G+Ls) are staff volunteers from the four Lower Mainland Health Authorities who encourage environmentally sustainable behavior and workplace improvements. G+Ls receive training and resources to support waste reduction, energy conservation, green transportation, and social sustainability.

G+L activities include educational lunches, celebrations, special projects and more! The position involves 2-4 hours of work time per month from October to May, plus a special, 8-hour training session (with a supervisor's permission).

You have a keen interest in and commitment to working towards sustainability in all its dimensions. You are energetic, outgoing, professional and willing to learn, and you have the ability to communicate patiently and clearly with others.
