

What is CART ?

CART (Communication Access Realtime Translation) is a service that links health care professional to a live captioner who types out the exact words during medical appointment. It's designed for hard-of-hearing patients who do not use sign language to communicaite.



Al vs. Live Captioner: What's the Difference? Live captioner is trained professional who type out everything in real-time, handling complex medical terms. They provide more accurate captions than AI relies on software that can misinterpret complex words, unclear speech, or specialized vocabulary.
