





CST CERNER STUDENT TRAINING UPDATE

Summer 2023

With CST continuing to roll out to new sites this year, we are happy to share the latest updates on CST Cerner student training. Through this collaboration, we want to ensure students are supported and successful in their documentation within the electronic health record.

KEY INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS AT FUTURE CST CERNER LIVE SITES

VCH:

- Vancouver General Hospital (VGH) will bring remaining ambulatory clinics onto the system in cycles, starting with Clinic Cycle 1 on July 24, 2023.
- UBC Hospital (UBCH), Purdy, Detwiller and Banfield Pavilions, Djavad Mowafaghian Centre for Brain Health, and priority clinics are on track to roll out CST Cerner in fall 2023.

PHSA:

- BC Cancer Prince George will be the second BC Cancer centre to roll out CST Cerner and is set to go-live on June 26, 2023.
- **BC Children's & Women's hospitals and campus (C&W)** is moving forward with ambulatory clinic cycles, starting with Clinic Cycle 1 in **summer 2023**.
- BC Mental Health and Substance Use Services (BCMHSUS) is preparing for a fall 2023 rollout at Forensic Psychiatric Hospital.

Students and clinical instructors will be enrolled into the online curriculum by the CST Learning team. To support this, **student names must be confirmed in HSPnet four weeks prior to the start of placement**. CONTACT INFORMATION FOR SITES ALREADY LIVE WITH CST CERNER

The training process is different for sites that are already using CST Cerner and sites that have not yet implemented CST Cerner.

The IMITS' Acute & Ambulatory Information Services team oversees education for sites already live with CST Cerner. This includes Lion's Gate Hospital, St. Paul's Hospital, BC Cancer – Vancouver and more. Students who are placed at any of the <u>live sites listed here</u> should contact <u>CSTCernerTraining@phsa.ca</u> with their questions.

KEY REMINDERS:

LearningHub is the online learning management platform used to register users into their training. Students are required to use their academic email in LearningHub.

Students need to use the Network Accounts (ADID) associated with the health authority of the first CST Cerner site where they were placed. For example, if students first accessed CST Cerner while placed at PHC and are now starting their placement at VCH, they are to use their PHC network account as the CST Cerner login.
