

## Student and On-site Faculty/Instructor Learning Requirements

## Hazardous Drugs

Across BC new regulations are being implemented by the National Institute of Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) and WorkSafe BC. At PHSA, these requirements come into effect February 2022, when all students and on-site faculty or instructors will be required to complete e-learning modules on the LearningHub, specific to their discipline.

- These requirements apply for all students and on-site faculty or instructors who have clinical placements at any PHSA site.
- The current cytotoxic drug list will be replaced with a more comprehensive hazardous drug list and exposure control program.
