

Downloading the Provider App on a Personal Mac Desktop

Downloading the BC Virtual Visit Provider Application on a personal Mac Desktop

IMPORTANT: You should use the **BC Virtual Visit Provider** app to connect to all of your appointments. If you are using a personal or unmanaged device please download the BC Virtual Visit Provider App from your app Store.

Note: Depending on your App Store settings, you may be prompted to enter a password, use Face ID or Touch ID to complete the download process. If you require assistance at this step, please refer to support documents on the Apple website as required: Resetting Apple ID, Touch ID, Face ID.

- 1. Open a browser window (Chrome, Firefox or Safari) and enter the Health Authority or Health Organisation specific URL.
- 2. You will be directed to the webpage shown below. Click the **Download App** button. This will initiate the downloading of the Desktop Application on to your device's hard drive.
