### PHSA Medical Staff Bylaws, item 4.6.2

In the event that a member of the Medical Staff wishes to resign from the Medical Staff:

- (a) the member must provide 60 days prior written notice to PHSA;
- (b) the notice requirement is not applicable in circumstances where resignation is based upon advice received by the member from the appropriate Department Head or regulatory college; and
- (c) the Board of Directors may waive or reduce the notice requirement for a member of the Medical Staff if satisfied that this requirement would be unreasonable or would cause undue hardship in the circumstances in which notice is being given by the member of the Medical Staff.
