

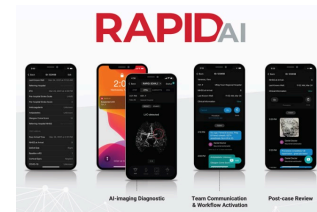

**Follow these new guidelines**


If you see someone in cardiac arrest, **every second counts**. It's a critical medical emergency. Follow the steps below – and note that guidelines have been updated to recommend providing rescue breaths during CPR:



**Phone 9-1-1 and shout for an AED.**



**Start CPR right away.**  
Give 2 breaths, if willing, after every 30 compressions.



**Use an AED as soon as one is available.**
