

Access the Infant RSV Immunization Request eForm

A. Go to <https://www.eforms.healthbc.org/login>.

The Provincial eForms Solution eForms Launcher page will display.

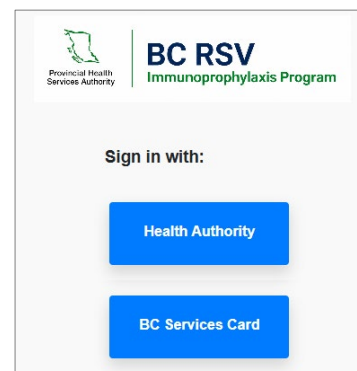
1. Select **BC RSV**.



2. The images on the right will display.

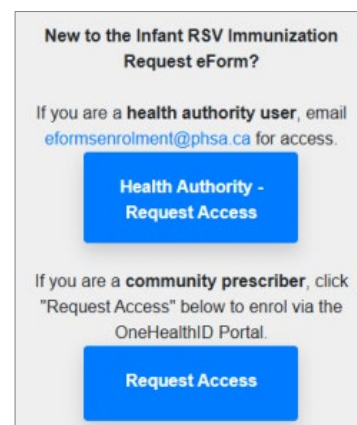
If you **already use Immunization eForms** and/or the **Special Authority eForm** and:

- work for a health authority, click **Health Authority**
- are a community practitioner, click **BC Services Card**

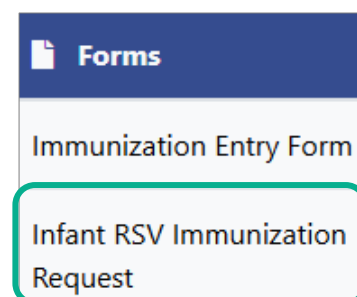


If you **DO NOT** use Immunization eForms and/or the Special Authority eForm, and you:

- work for a health authority, click **Health Authority – Request Access**
- are a community practitioner, click **Request Access**



3. Once you're logged in, in the left side of the screen, select **Infant RSV Eligibility Checklist**.



Complete the Infant RSV Immunization Request eForm

4. The *Client Search* box will open. Enter the child's **PHN**. Click **Search**.
5. Confirm the child's personal information. Click **Select**.
6. A *Provider Search* box will open. Enter the **Provider Name** or **ID Type** and **ID Number**. Click **Search**. Results will display. Click on your **Provider**. Click **Select**. If your provider doesn't display, click **Skip**.
7. The *Infant RSV Eligibility Checklist* screen will display, with the child and *Provider's* data populated. The *Date of Appointment* default to today's date.
8. If the child is 2 years old or older, the message on the right will display. **Do not complete the form.**

Eligibility Outcome

This child is not eligible for the RSV immunization program due to age. DO NOT COMPLETE THIS FORM.
9. Scroll down to the RSVab Immunization Eligibility History section. If "Special Population – High risk for RSV under 24 months (*)" is listed, **do not complete the form.**

If "Special Population - High risk for RSV under 24 months" is listed below, this infant/child has already been identified as eligible for RSV immunization. DO NOT COMPLETE THIS FORM.

- ☐ Chronic lung disease, including bronchopulmonary dysplasia AND requiring ongoing assisted ventilation, oxygen therapy (e.g. Home O2, CPAP, BIPAP)
- ☐ Hemodynamically significant congenital cardiac disease or cardiomyopathy
- ☐ Severe or profound combined immunodeficiencies (e.g. SCID, CD40 ligand deficiency, DOCK8, etc.; Please note that adjudication by a Pediatric Immunologist is required in those cases).
- ☐ Severely impaired ability to clear respiratory secretions due to a congenital airway anomaly or neuromuscular disease
- ☐ Cystic fibrosis with respiratory involvement and/or growth delay
- ☐ Down syndrome and other trisomy syndromes
- ☐ Prematurity: Infants born below 32 weeks of gestation after March 31, 2025

11. Follow the instructions in the Eligibility Outcome to complete or not complete the form.

Eligibility Outcome

Eligibility for RSV immunization TBD following birth parent immunization assessment. COMPLETE THIS FORM.

Complete the form and submit it. Public health will contact the birth parent to determine eligibility. If the child is eligible, public health will follow up to immunize the child.

Eligibility Outcome

Eligible for RSV immunization. COMPLETE THIS FORM.

If the Outcome is “**Eligible for RSV immunization**”, complete the rest of the form and submit it. Public health will follow up to immunize the child.
